



GET YOUR FAMILY TO THE DIRTIEST DAY OF CAMCO GROUP MOTORMANIA CQ

A full day of the cleanest family fun you'll ever have in the mud is in order at the Mud Racing Day at Kabra as part of Camco Group MotorMania CQ.

Watch adventurous drivers battle one another for the best time on mud-slopped tracks at the Kabra track, just behind the Kabra Hotel off Scrubby Creek Road in Kabra from 9am – 4pm on Saturday 17 July.

These races are sure to provide amusement like no other!

Mud racing, popular for almost ten years now in Rockhampton and the surrounding area, is an excellent destination for families, car-lovers, and entertainment seekers of all ages.

Two muddy figure-8 tracks will allow drivers to test their skills against the elements and against each other for the best time and greatest "wow" moment.

"These tracks often have jumps and muddy splash pits located throughout the circuits where many of the competitors become airborne and out of control through the muddy terrain," President of CQ Mudsportz, Marlene Granshaw, elaborates.

Four classes will compete – Junior Class (10 to 16 year olds), Standard Class, Buggy Class, and Top Gun Class – so prepare for a variety of skill levels and different techniques for blasting through the mud.

Specifically designed and outfitted for the rough environment, you'll just have to see these cars to believe them!

"Standard Class and Buggy Class are modified and allowed to put chains on their tyres, and the Top Gun Class are high powered, specially built cars machined in two- and rear-wheel drive using Nos, Methanol, Super Chargers and Turbos," remarked Granshaw.

Vehicles compete two at a time, one car on each track, and then swap tracks to complete the heat for a combined time.

"At the end of the Qualifying Rounds a competitor's three fastest heats are combined together to give placing for the night," said Granshaw.

Definitely don't miss the last round, where the fastest four competitors in each class will battle it out for final placing.

More entertainment will follow after the races and the All Hours Glass Grid Girls will be there cheering on the competitors, so be sure not to miss out.

"Racing will finish at 4:00pm with trophy presentation following, and we are also having a DJ after the event," said Granshaw.

Bring camping chairs due to limited seating and make yourself comfortable for a dirty day in the Central Queensland sunshine.

Bar and canteen facilities will be available and camping is also available at the track free of charge.

Tickets are \$15.00 for adults, \$5.00 for children, or \$40.00 for a family (2 adults and 4 children). Kids under 5 are free.
